

In May 2018, a search was run in the **PubMed** database using the search phrase “(YouTube[Title] and (Educational Measurement[MeSH Terms] or Video Recording[MeSH Terms] OR Information Dissemination[MeSH Terms] or Social Media[MeSH Terms] or YouTube[Other Term])”. This search provided 306 papers.

- Consultamos diccionario temático
- Consultamos términos en la prensa
- Otros buscadores: Bing/Google/Google Scholar/Yandex




Fig - Years of publication of selected articles.

Because of RDM services and possible new services, in some research libraries new library positions have emerged such as "data curator", "data librarian", "data scientist", "data specialist", "data visualization librarian", "digital stewardship", "research data support", or "science librarian" (Ball, 2013; Bradley-Ridout, 2018; Corrall et al., 2013; Kim & Syn, 2021; Shipman & Tang, 2019; Tenopir et al., 2014).
